

ORDINANCE 2014- 14

An Ordinance of City of Harrodsburg, Kentucky, revising the "Ethics Policy."

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to amend the Ethics Policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Harrodsburg, the above Ordinance is amended to read as follows:

Amend Section 21; the enforcement section of the Ethics policy described as follows:


ENFORCEMENT SECTION 21. Board of Ethics Created.

(A) There is hereby created a Board of Ethics which shall have the authorities, duties and responsibilities as set forth in this Ordinance to enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

(B) The Board of Ethics- shall consist of seven (7) members who shall be appointed by the executive authority of the Legislative Bodies, subject to the approval of each Legislative Body (if different from the executive authority.) The initial members of the Board of Ethics shall be appointed within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this ordinance.-No member of the Board of Ethics shall hold any elected ~~or appointed~~ office, whether paid or unpaid, or any position of employment with the Legislative Body or any Legislative Bodies agency.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance was approved by the City Commissioners of Harrodsburg on the 27th day of October, 2014.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
