

ORDINANCE 2014-29

An Ordinance amending provisions of the City of Harrodsburg Code of Ordinances Chapter 92, Section 11.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Harrodsburg desires to amend a portion of the City of Harrodsburg Code of Ordinances Chapter 92, Section 11.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted by the City of Harrodsburg, Kentucky, that a portion of the Ordinance under "Streets and Sidewalks", Chapter 92, Section 11", is amended as follows:

Any person, public utility, or other excavator prior to removal or altering of any portion of a public street in the city for any purpose shall obtain a permit City Hall after posting a cash bond in an amount sufficient to indemnify the city for the restoration and repair of same. The amount of the cash bond shall be determined by the ~~City Engineer~~ **Public Works Superintendent** and approved by the Mayor. Immediately upon completion of the work, the person, public utility, or excavator shall immediately fill the ditch to the surface with densely graded rock and restore the original type surface to the street, according to state specifications, within a period of 48 hours, and thereafter upon approval of the ~~City Engineer~~ **Public Works Superintendent** the bond will be refunded.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon second reading and publication of this Ordinance.

The foregoing Ordinance was introduced and read for the first time on the 22 day of December, 2014, at a regular meeting, and for the second time, adopted and approved, at its regular meeting on the 12 day of January 2015, 2014; and published in the Harrodsburg Herald on the 22 day of January 2015, 2014.
