HARRODSBURG CITY COMMISSION MERCER COUNTY, KY ORDINANCE NO. 2017-05

WHEREAS, Office Street, a City street, from U.S. 127 to Chiles Street, Harrodsburg, Kentucky, is currently designated as a two-way traffic street.

WHEREAS, a recommendation has been made to change the portion of Office Street from U.S. 127 to Chiles Street to a one-way street, with traffic only allowed to travel in an easterly direction, from U.S. 127 to Chiles Street, Harrodsburg, Kentucky;

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has determined such a change to be in the best interest of the City.

WHEREAS, by having Office Street from U.S. 127 to Chiles Street a one-way street would provide more parking.

WHEREAS, City of Harrodsburg's Code of Ordinance #71.08, provides that a portion of the street can be designated as an angle or diagonal parking zone.

WHEREAS, more parking would be provided if the parking spaces on the north side of Office Street from U.S. 127 to Chiles Street be designated as only diagonal parking, the south side of the street shall continue to only allow parallel parking.

NOW THEREFORE, be it Ordained by the City Commission of Harrodsburg as follows:

- 1. Office Street, Harrodsburg, Kentucky from U.S. 127 to Chiles Street, be designated as a one-way street, and that the direction of vehicle traffic shall only be in an easterly direction from U.S. 127 to Chiles Street, Harrodsburg, Kentucky, and the street be appropriately marked by signs as approved by the Manuel on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).
- 2. That parking spaces on the north side of Office Street be diagonal parking only and shall be appropriately marked by signs. The south side of this portion of Office Street shall remain as parallel parking only. See attached plat describing the traffic flow pattern and diagonal parking spaces.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and appropriate signs being displayed.
